IN THE MATTER OF DECLARATION  
OF FORMATION OF THE SANTA YNEZ } RESOLUTION NO. 71- 773  
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT }

WHEREAS, on the 9th day of November, 1971, an election was held, pursuant to law, in the proposed Santa Ynez Community Services District to determine the question of whether the proposed district should or should not be organized and also to elect five directors in case the district should be organized; and

WHEREAS, the County Clerk, pursuant to the authority granted him by the Board of Supervisors under Resolution No.71-650, did, on November 10, 1971, canvass the returns of said election and found and ascertained that the total number of votes cast thereat was 121; that of such number 93 votes were in favor of the formation of the proposed district and 24 votes were against such formation; and that a majority of the votes cast were and are in favor of the formation of the proposed district; and

WHEREAS, it appears from the canvass of the returns of such election that the following persons have received the following number of votes respectively for the office of director of such district:

1                   AND WHEREAS, it appears that the following five nominees:  
2 Alton J. Turk, Leonard Charles Kelsey, A. W. (Bill) Nelson, Tony  
3 Hernandez and John J. Pappas have received respectively the high-  
4 est number of votes for director of such district,

5                   NOW, THEREFORE BE IT AND IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND RESOLVED  
6 as follows:

7                   1) That all of the territory within the boundaries here-  
8 inafter described be, and the same is, duly organized as a com-  
9 munity services district under the name of "Santa Ynez Community  
10 Services District" in accordance with the provisions of Title 5,  
11 Division 3 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

12                   2) The territory above-mentioned and which is hereby  
13 declared to be organized as such community services district is  
14 situated in the County of Santa Barbara and is bounded and de-  
15 scribed as shown in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and made a part  
16 hereof; and

17                   3) The purposes for which the subject district is formed  
18 are as follows:

- 19                   (a) To supply the inhabitants of the district with  
20 water for domestic use, irrigation, sanitation,  
21 industrial use, fire protection, and recreation.  
22                   (b) The collection, treatment or disposal of sewage,  
23 waste and storm water of the district and its  
24 inhabitants.  
25                   (c) The collection or disposal of garbage or refuse  
26 matter.  
27                   (d) Protection against fire.  
28                   (e) Public recreation by means of parks, including  
29 but not limited to aquatic parks and recreat-  
30 ional harbors, playgrounds, golf courses,  
31 swimming pools or recreation buildings.  
32                   (f) Street lighting.

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- (g) Mosquito abatement.
  - (h) The equipment and maintenance of a police department or other police protection to protect and safeguard life and property.
  - (i) To acquire sites for, construct, and maintain library buildings, and to co-operate with other governmental agencies for library service.
  - (j) The opening, widening, extending, straightening, and surfacing in whole or part of any street in such district, subject to the consent of the governing body of the county or city in which said improvement is to be made.
  - (k) The construction and improvement of bridges, culverts, curbs, gutters, drains, and works incidental to the purposes specified in subdivision (j), subject to the consent of the governing body of the county or city in which said improvement is to be made.
  - (l) The conversion of existing overhead electric and communication facilities to underground locations, which facilities are owned and operated by either a 'public agency' or a 'public utility' as defined in Section 5896.2 of the Streets and Highways Code, and to take proceedings for and to finance the cost of such conversion in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 28 (commencing with Section 5896.1 of Part 3 of Division 7 of the Streets and Highways Code, subject to the consent of the public agency or public utility responsible for the owning, operation and maintenance of such facilities.
- Nothing herein contained shall be construed as

1 giving a district formed under this law the  
2 power to install, own or operate such facilities  
3 as are described in this subdivision.

4 4) The following named persons have been duly elected  
5 as directors of the Santa Ynez Community Services District and  
6 the County Clerk is hereby directed to issue certificates of  
7 election forthwith to such persons: Alton J. Turk, Leonard Charles  
8 Kelsey, A. W. (Bill) Nelson, Tony Hernandez, and John J. Pappas,  
9 and

10 5) Each and all of the proceedings requisite and neces-  
11 sary for legal organization of such district and the election of  
12 such directors have been done and performed according to law, and

13 6) This resolution shall be entered immediately upon  
14 the minutes of this meeting and a duly certified copy thereof shall  
15 be filed immediately by the Clerk of this Board for recordation  
16 in the office of the Santa Barbara County Recorder and duly  
17 certified copies thereof shall be filed with the California Secre-  
18 tary of State, and the California State Board of Equalization.

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Beginning at the point of intersection of the westerly line of Calzada Avenue with the westerly prolongation of the northerly line of that certain 53.91 acre tract of land shown upon the map thereof filed in Book 15 at page 376 of Maps in said County Recorder's office; thence S 89° 34' 00" E, along said prolongation to and along said northerly line, 1232.36 feet to the northwest corner of Tract No. 10,210, Unit No. 2, as said tract is shown upon the map thereof filed in Book 58 at page 79 of Maps in said County Recorder's office; thence S 89° 35' 00" E, along the northerly line of said tract to and along the northerly line of Tract No. 10,210, Unit No. 1, a distance of 2119.74 feet to the northwest corner of Tract No. 10,148, as said tract is shown upon the map thereof filed in Book 55 at page 82 of Maps in said County Recorder's office; thence S 89° 34' 00" E, along the northerly line of said tract, 550.09 feet to the northeast corner thereof, being a point in the easterly line of Meadow Vale, formerly known as Border Street and Santa Barbara Street, said point also being shown as "A" at an angle point of that certain 3221.00 net acre tract of land shown upon the map thereof filed in Book 25 at page 83 of Record of Surveys in said County Recorder's office; thence S 0° 10' 00" W, along the westerly line of said 3221.00 acre tract of land and the easterly line of Meadow Vale, 3869.00 feet to its intersection with the southerly line of State Highway No. 246; thence westerly along the southerly boundary line of said highway the following bearings and distances; S 89° 35' 20" W, 550.20 feet; S 72° 47' 29" W, 138.42 feet; S 89° 35' 20" W, 357.77 feet; S 0° 24' 40" E, 66.22 feet; S 72° 47' 29" W, 41.69 feet; thence leaving said State Highway S 0° 24' 40" E, 81.69 feet to the southerly line of Valley Street; thence along the southerly line of said Valley Street, S 89° 35' 20" W 2017.02 feet to a point in the southerly right of way line of State Highway No. 246, being a point on a 1950.00 foot radius curve to the left, concave southeasterly the radial center of which bears S 26° 35' 01" E; thence westerly along the arc of said curve
